INSTRUCTIONS TO MANUFACTURERS/SUPPLIERS AND USERS OF SOLAR WATER HEATING SYSTEMS ON MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR INSTALLATIONS IN THE FIELD

All the Manufacturers/Suppliers of Solar Water Heating Systems are instructed to strictly adhere to minimum requirements set by MNRE for installations in the field as placed on website. As per the guidelines, they also need to give an undertaking confirming to the requirements being followed by them while submitting proposals to MNRE/SNAs for subsidy. They also need to provide detailed specifications of each and every part of their system to the beneficiary along with Operation and Maintenance manual. Salient features of the system installed also need to be highlighted on a plate fixed on front surface of the tank along with name of Manufacturers/dealers and his contact number. In case, any of the Manufacturers/Supplier is found not adhering to these requirements, his name will be removed from MNRE list and also debarred from direct participation under Subsidy programme on Solar Water Heating Systems.

Beneficiaries of Solar Water Heating Systems are also requested to ensure that these requirements are met by the Manufacturers/Suppliers while getting systems installed at their establishments. The requirements are available on MNRE website mnre.gov.in.
